

## **Evidence Based Medicine (EBM) Lead Faculty Position Education Deliverables**

The EBM Lead Faculty will work collaboratively with Scholar, Curriculum, Assessment and Evaluation, and Faculty Development Leads as well as the appropriate site faculty to develop and support the EBM component of the scholarship curriculum and assessment for the distributed UBC family medicine residency program.

Job responsibilities would include:

1. Biannual review of the EBM program (curriculum and assessment)
2. Assess current state of EBM teaching and assessment at each site and work with local faculty to identify gaps in site resources and faculty development needs.
3. Explore opportunities to collaborate with Scholar and other Leads in curriculum development and delivery (curriculum tools, video-conferencing, academic days etc.)
4. Develop faculty development strategy with Faculty Development Lead to best prepare faculty and preceptors to support the EBM program.
5. Participate in lead faculty meetings to represent and hear EBM issues.
6. Assist with orientation of new sites regarding EBM curriculum delivery and assessment
7. Liaise with other national colleagues on “best practices” for teaching and assessing EBM.
8. Regular communication and curriculum coordination with Curriculum / Assessment / Faculty Development Leads
