

EDUCATION DELIVERABLES
SITE FACULTY – BEHAVIORAL MEDICINE

Overview of the Position

- The Behavioral Medicine Site Faculty will organize and teach (where appropriate) the behavioral medicine academic curriculum at the site. The Site Faculty member will liaise appropriately through the Behavioral Medicine committee.

Specific Responsibilities

- To organize the behavioral medicine components of the site academic and clinical curriculum (in conjunction with the site director and site faculty for curriculum) which are consistent with program and accreditation expectations.
- Site Faculty (working with Assessment Faculty) will establish a comprehensive program in Direct Observation/Video Review.
- Membership on the following committees:
 - Behavioral Medicine Committee
 - Site Resident Education Committee
- Support exam prep particularly related to communication skills
- Participate in Site strategic planning and faculty development as required

Program requirements

- Participation (maximum 8 hours per year) in the collaborative resident selection process both at the Program level and at the site level, as well as department wide function of the UBC Department of Family Medicine

Reporting:

- The Site faculty reports to their Site Director and the Lead faculty for Behavioral Medicine

Qualifications

- CCFP or equivalent professional certification for Allied Health Professionals
- Eligible for licensure in British Columbia
- Demonstrated ability in teaching and working with residents

Remuneration

To be determined through consultation with Program Director and Site Director depending on the size of the site and the time required to meet responsibilities
