

Role Clarification for PI on Resident Scholar Project

There may be some occasional exceptions for PI, but in general this is what is expected as of 1 July 2016

PI (Principal Investigator)	Other research preceptors or scholar mentors
<p>Has a Clinical Faculty Appt > or = Clinical Assistant Professor</p> <p>Has completed the annual COI module</p> <p>Has made ethics submissions on UBC RISE in the past and has an active account.</p> <p>Usually an established primary healthcare (or equiv) researcher.</p> <p>Scholar faculty are default PI if no one else</p>	<p>No clinical faculty appointment required.</p> <p>Often a family doctor, but may be from another field of expertise.</p>
<p>Has enough familiarity with METHODS and/or content of proposed scholar project to guide:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. writing of excellent research question, 2. a full research proposal, 3. ethics and 4. final paper. 	<p>Has appropriate content/clinical knowledge to advise resident regarding.</p> <p>May have very specific kind of support that is being offered to resident, e.g. writing in a second language</p>
<p>Is invited to be an author on the paper submitted. If not included as an author, is recognized in acknowledgements.</p>	<p>May be an author, or recognized in acknowledgements.</p> <p>May help resident bring project to publication.</p>
<p>Has appropriate availability to provide the TIME NEEDED to support the resident in all phases of the project, e.g.:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Design of question - 1-10h 2) Writing of proposal 2-10h 3) Submission of ethics 2-10h 4) Navigation of implementing study - highly variable 5) Writing abstract 1-5h 6) Writing results and preparing presentation 5-15 hours 7) General support - variable 	<p>Can be available as requested for specific consultations.</p> <p>Will usually amount to 5-6 hours per year.</p> <p>Responds to emails/requests for help from residents within 24-72 hours</p>
<p>Attends Trial Run and/or Research Day and other presentations made by the resident.</p> <p>Provides post-Research Day support to get project published.</p>	<p>Attends Trial Run and/or Research Day.</p>
